Failure to complete programing requirements - failure to meet competencies of assigned program

Class A DOR - Class A Disciplinary Offence Report

Program Refusal - Offenders refuses to participate in recommended programs

Cardinal Rule Violation - Rules established in Therapeutic and community models. Violation of these rules result in immediate removal from program

IDOC LEVEL OF CARE:

MHP- Offenders at this level of care have been symptom and medication free for three months or more and do not require further mental health treatment unless requested.

MHMN- Offenders at this level of care do not meet criteria for a Major Mental Illness but are experiencing some degree of symptomatology, or there is a need for further evaluation if symptoms persist, or they are experiencing symptoms of mental illness secondary to a medical condition.

CMHS 1- Offenders at this level of care are able to function in either a general population (GP) setting or a specialized unit with minimal mental health support. They may be prescribed psychotropic medications.

CMHS 2- Offenders at this level of care are able to function in a general population (GP) setting with medication management services. They are prescribed psychotropic medications and can request group therapy.

ICHMS- Offenders at this level of care are unable to function in the general population without assistance. They require more intensive mental health services. They are typically housed in a special housing unit.

ACHMS- Offenders with this level of care exhibit a mental illness with sufficient severity to prohibit their interaction with general population (GP). In most cases they present as floridly psychotic or with debilitating mood instability. Due to the severity of their illness, they are placed in a more restrictive environment in which treatment can be initiated without fear of the offender being victimized or victimizing others.

INITIAL CRIME TYPE:

Alcohol - Crime wherein alcohol played a role in the commission of crime(s).

Assault - Crime wherein intentional act by one person that creates an apprehension in another of an imminent harmful or offensive contact.

Drug - Crime wherein drugs played a role in the commission of crime(s).

Murder/Man - Murder - crime of killing somebody: the crime of killing another person deliberately and not in self-defense or with any other extenuating circumstance recognized by law: Manslaughter - unpremeditated killing: the unlawful killing of one person by another without advance planning

Property - Crimes that includes, among other crimes, burglary larceny , theft , motor vehicle theft arson, shoplifting , and vandalism. Property crime only involves the taking of money or property, and does not involve force or threat of force against a victim.

Sex - Crimes such as rape, molestation, or sexual abuse, involving illegal or coerced sexual activity.

DUAL STAUS OFFENDER:

Offender is classified as both a Termer and Rider

SANCTIONS/INTERVENTIONS - USED PRIOR TO RECOMMENDATION OF RELEQUESMENT: - **Sanctions** - Actions designed for consequences that could be positive and/or negative in order to modify the undesirable behavior. **Interventions:** Actions which are not sanctions but which provide an opportunity for the offender to reflect on his criminal thinking and conduct.

RIDER TYPE's:

Traditional - Substance abuse treatment program for moderate risk offenders with educational needs. Curriculum is designed to be typically completed in 120 days

CAPP - Intensive substance abuse program for moderate risk offenders. Curriculum is designed to typically be completed in 90 days.

TC - Therapeutic Community is an intensive substance abuse program for high risk offenders. Curriculum is designed to be typically completed in 270 days.

Mental Health - Substance abuse treatment program designed to incorporate elements of mental health maintenance strategies and treatment and reentry focused on the special needs of mental health offenders. Curriculum is designed to be typically completed in 180 days.

SOTP - Sex offender assessment program designed to incorporate assessment and treatment concepts for those retained jurisdiction offenders who have been convicted of or have a history of sex offending behavior. Substance abuse treatment is included for offenders assessing with substance abuse need. Curriculum is designed to be typically completed in 180 days.

CRP - Substance abuse treatment program designed to incorporate elements of anger management for offenders with history of violent offenses. Curriculum is designed to be typically completed in 160 days.
